To ensure the broadest possible recognition, several partners have been invited to nominate candidates from their communities or organizations for this national honour. Your contribution as a nominating partner is greatly appreciated.

This medal program is administered by the Chancellery of Honours, as part of the Office of the Secretary to the Governor General (OSGG).

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this honour, a person must have:

- Made significant contributions to the country, a province, territory, region or community, or made an outstanding achievement abroad that brings credit to Canada; and
- Been alive on May 6, 2023, the date His Majesty was crowned.
 Nominations can be made posthumously as long as the nominee was alive on that date.
- The Medal may only be awarded once.
