The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) issues Decision 28831-D01-2024, approving the sale of the Village of Boyle Gas Utility to Apex Utilities Inc.

As of September 1, 2024, Apex Utilities Inc. will be the owner of the natural gas distribution system in Boyle and provider of natural gas to our residents.

The Village will be sending out an Apex welcome and information package to all Boyle gas utility customers in the following weeks.

PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES BYLAW 05-24

If you are looking to build a new home, upgrade your commercial building or build new, and find a way to attract a new business to rent your vacant building space, then the Village of Boyle has a tax incentive program to help you achieve these development goals.

The bylaw provides property Tax Incentives in the following categories:

- 1) Non-Residential property tax exemptions for new buildings, and expansion and refurbishment of existing buildings.
- 2) Non-Residential property tax exemptions for new businesses in vacant buildings.
- 3) Residential property tax exemptions for new residential housing development.
